Safety & Health Responsibilities

Employers have the most authority at the workplace, and therefore the most responsibility to ensure workplace safety and health.

Employers must

- take necessary precautions to ensure the safety, health and welfare of workers
- provide and maintain a safe workplace, and safe equipment, tools and systems
- provide new workers with a safety and health orientation
- ensure all workers and supervisors are aware of hazards in the workplace as well as any necessary precautions
- provide workers with competent supervision
- provide training to protect workers' safety and health before they begin a new job
- take precautions to ensure other persons are not exposed to safety or health risks due to workplace activities
- consult and co-operate with the workplace safety and health committee or representative
- co-operate with others on workplace safety and health matters

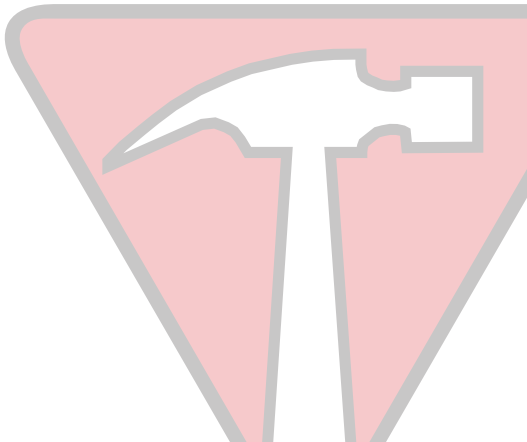

WORKER **Safety & Health Responsibilities**

Workers are responsible for their own actions or inaction in the workplace.

Workers must

- follow safety and health rules and SAFE work procedures at the workplace
- take reasonable care to protect themselves and others who may be affected by their actions or omissions
- use safety equipment, clothing, and devices properly
- co-operate with the workplace safety and health committee or representative
- co-operate with others on workplace safety and health matters
