### ***Contest Information***

SAFE Work Manitoba invites students of the Occupational Health & Safety Program to tap into their creativity by creating projects that promote SAFE work to young Manitobans for a chance to win a cash prize of \$2,500!

We're looking for projects that focus on:

- safety and health training and orientation for workers beginning a new job or changing work duties
- rights and responsibilities of people in the workplace (e.g., workers, employers, supervisors).

This year's theme is "There's no room for bullying at work". Bullying and harassment in the workplace are serious matters. If not prevented, these issues can cause psychological or mental health problems for workers. If a worker becomes distressed due to harassment, they may be unable to concentrate on the job and stay alert to hazards. If left unchecked, bullying and harassment can even lead to violence. Fortunately, we can take steps to prevent bullying and harassment at work. We must be aware of our own behaviour toward others and report any inappropriate behaviour we see in the workplace that might affect our ability to work safely.

### ***Prizes***

SAFE Work Manitoba will judge all eligible entries and select the project that best illustrates the theme and promotes innovation, education and awareness of SAFE work to young workers.

**One winner will be selected and awarded \$2,500!**
